Free Weekly Meals On-Site:

- Friday Breakfast: 7:30am-8:15am.
- Wednesday Soup Line: 3:00pm-4:00pm.

- Food Bank: Call (780) 425-4190 for an appointment.
- **ID Program*:** Have you been homeless and without ID? We can help you get one!
- Pathway of Hope: Do you envision a brighter future? Partnering together to set goals and helping you reach them
- Starter Kits*: small household items for those who are just starting out in a new place and who don't have much.
- Baby Layettes: infant essential package for newborns.
- Emergency Thrift Store Vouchers*: for those who are in an emergency situation for clothing, housewares and/or furniture.

Walk-In:

- Bread Run: Free bread every day, while supplies last.
- OneSight Referral*: glasses and vision test provided through LensCrafters for those with no coverage through benefits.
- Christmas Assistance*: registration in the Fall for individuals and families.

- Income Tax Program*: Free current year income tax preparation for individuals from March 12, 2018

- After Tax Program: Free previous year income tax preparation for low income persons: Every Friday from mid-May until the end of Nov from 9am-I lam.

- **Bus tickets:** for appointments or to get home.
